

Update on school bus and community service arrangements in the Huon Valley

Updated 8 February 2019

The safety of students and staff during the current bushfire period remains a primary concern.

Due to the opening of the Huon Highway south of Huonville, the Geeveston Child and Family Centre – wayraparattee and the Geeveston Library will now be open to the community on Tuesday 12 February.

With the re-opening of a number of roads, but with school closures still in place, some school bus routes have been amended by Department of State Growth to deliver students to the alternative school sites.

School bus services will be in place on Tuesday 12 February in an amended state.
